

Wiring Instructions

Hondo National Bank allows our customers to send and receive domestic and foreign wire transfers with ease. The following is a list of our wire instructions for Incoming/Outgoing Domestic /Foreign wires.

Incoming Domestic Wire Instructions

To have funds wired from another financial institution to your account at HNB you will need to provide that institution with your HNB account name, account number, and HNB's ABA/Routing number: 114903174.

Outgoing Domestic Wire Instructions

To wire funds from HNB to another financial institution you will need to complete HNB's Wire Transfer Form and provide beneficiary information. Basic information needed would typically be the Beneficiary's name, physical address, account number, and ABA/Routing number.

Incoming International Wire Instructions

Please contact your local branch for Incoming International Wire instructions.

Outgoing International Wires Instructions

To send an International wire from HNB to a foreign financial institution you will need to complete HNB's Wire Transfer Form and provide beneficiary information. Basic information we will need is Beneficiary's name, physical address, account number/IBAN/CLAVE, country, and or swift code.
